

 An increased and targeted approach of Pasifika support staff will provide support for improving academic outcomes.










Summary to date

- Students contacted and referred to Support Team









Students supported

Other challenges

Reasons highlighted by students that needed support (most common):

- Family and church commitments
- Child care
- Lack of support from family
- Lack of good study space/time to study
- Financial commitments to family



Limitations

Timing of the project:

• Lack of time and resources

Communication

- Levels 4-9 > Students enrolled in multiple papers with multiple tutors
